—**Susan Rich** is the author of four collections of poetry, most recently, *Cloud Pharmacy* and *The Alchemist's Kitchen*, which was a Finalist for the Foreword Prize and the Washington State Book Award. Her other books include *Cures Include Travel* and *The Cartographer's Tongue Poems of the World*, which won the PEN USA Award for Poetry and the Peace Corps Writers Award. She is the recipient of awards from Artist's Trust, The Times Literary Supplement of London, Peace Corps Writers and the Fulbright Foundation. Individual poems appear in the *Antioch Review*, *Harvard Review*, and *Prairie Schooner*. She teaches at Highline Community College and lives in West Seattle, WA.

—**Kelli Russell Agodon** is the author of *Letters from the Emily Dickinson Room* (2010), winner of the ForeWord Magazine Book of the Year Prize in Poetry and a finalist for the Washington State Book Award. She is also the author of *Small Knots* (2004) and the chapbook, *Geography* (2003). She co-edited the first eBook anthology of contemporary women's poetry, *Fire On Her Tongue* and recently published *The Daily Poet*, a book of poetry writing exercises she coauthored with Martha Silano. Her third collection of poems, *Hourglass Museum*, will be published in February 2014. Kelli is the co-founder of Two Sylvias Press and was the editor of Seattle's literary journal, *Crab Creek Review* for the last five years.
