

—Arthur Ginsberg is a neurologist and poet based in Seattle. He has studied poetry at the University of Washington and at Squaw Valley with Galway Kinnell, Sharon Olds and Lucille Clifton. Recent work appears in the anthologies, Blood and Bone, and Primary Care, from University of Iowa Press. He was awarded the William Stafford prize in 2003. His full-length collection of poetry, *The Anatomist*, was published in 2013, and his chapbook, *Faith is the Next Breath*, is just out from Puddinghouse Press in Ohio. He was awarded an MFA degree in creative writing in 2010 from Pacific University in Forest Grove, Oregon.

—Lisa M. Steinman was born and raised in rural Connecticut and attended college in upstate New York before moving to the Pacific Northwest to teach at Reed College in Portland. Absence & Presence is her ninth book. Earlier poetry books include Lost Poems (Ithaca House), All That Comes to Light and A Book of Other Days (both from Arrowood Books), and Carslaw's Sequences (University of Tampa Press). She has three books about poetry, as well: Made in America (Yale University Press), Masters of Repetition (Palgrave Macmillan), and, most recently, Invitation to Poetry (Wiley-Blackwell). Since 1983, she and her husband, Jim Shuqrue, have edited the poetry magazine Hubbub. She is Kenan Professor of English & Humanities at Reed.
