—Jim Shugrue is the author of three chapbooks: *Floating Verses* (Barebone Books, 2011), *Small Things Screaming (*26 Books), which was a finalist for an Oregon Book Award; and *Icewater* (Trask House Books). He received a fellowship from the Oregon Arts Commission and an Open Voice Award. He co-edits, with his wife, Lisa Steinman, the poetry magazine *Hubbub*.

-Vern Rutsala is recognized as one of the most notable poets of the Pacific Northwest. Beginning with *The Window* in 1964, he has published over fifteen books of poetry. *How We Spent Our Time* won the 2004 Akron Poetry Prize, and *The Moment's Equation* was a finalist for the 2005 National Book Award. Among his many awards are Guggenheim and National Endowment for the Arts fellowships. He taught at Lewis & Clark College from 1961 – 2005 and, as an imposing and significant figure on the local and national poetry scene, he has been a mentor and an inspiration to poets everywhere.
