Zachary Schomburg, a poet, novelist, illustrator and translator, was born in Omaha, Nebraska in 1977, and raised in Iowa. He earned a BA from the College of the Ozarks and a PhD in creative writing-poetry from the University of Nebraska. His books of poetry include *The Man Suit* (2007), *Scary*, *No Scary* (2009), and *Fjords vol* 1 (2012), and *The Book of Joshua* (2014), all from Black Ocean Press. His novel, *Mammother*, was published this fall from Featherproof Books. He is the publisher and editor of Octopus Books, and co-curator of the Bad Blood readings series. He lives and teaches in Portland, Oregon.

Ed Skoog was born in Topeka, Kansas in 1971. He graduated from Kansas State University and holds an MFA from the University of Montana. His books of poetry include *Mister Skylight, Rough Day* (winner of the Washington State Book Award) and *Run the Red Lights,* all published by Copper Canyon Press. Skoog has taught at the Idyllwild Arts Foundation, the New Orleans Center for Creative Arts, and Tulane University, and he has been a visiting writer at George Washington University, Wichita State University, the University of Montana, and the Richard Hugo House. The poetry editor of Okey-Panky, and co-host, with novelist J. Robert Lennon, of the podcast Lunch Box, with Ed and John, Skoog lives and teaches in Portland, Oregon.
