Nance Van Winckel's sixth collection of poems, *Pacific Walkers,* is just out from U. of Washington Press. The recipient of two NEA Poetry Fellowships, the Washington Sate Governor's Award for Poetry, and awards from the Poetry Society of America, *Poetry,* and *Prairie Schooner,* she has new poems in *The Pushcart Prize Anthology, The Southern Review, Poetry Northwest, Crazyhorse, Field,* and *Gettysburg Review.* Her fourth collection of linked stories and flash fiction, *Boneland* (U. of Oklahoma Press, July 2013), won a Christopher Isherwood Fiction Fellowship. Her flash fictions, short-shorts, and full-length stories have been published in *AGNI, The Massachusetts Review, The Sun, Kenyon Review,* and other journals. Her hybrid mash-ups of poetry and photography have been in several gallery shows and literary journals. She is Professor Emerita in Eastern Wash-ington University's graduate creative writing program, as well as a faculty member of Vermont College of Fine Arts' low-residency MFA program. She has taught at Bucknell U., Randolph College, U. of Montana, Centrum, and other schools. She lives near Spokane, Washington with her husband, the artist Rik Nelson.
