Joe Wilkins is the author of the memoir, *The Mountain and the Fathers* (2012), which was named a 2012 Montana Book Award Honor Book, as well as a 2013 *Orion* Book Award finalist. He has also published two poetry collections: *Killing the Murnion Dogs* (2011), a finalist for the Paterson Poetry Prize and the High Plains Book Award, and *Notes from the Journey Westward* (2012), winner of the White Pine Press Poetry Prize and the High Plains Book Award. His essays, poems, and stories have appeared in many magazines, journals and anthologies. Wilkins was born and raised in eastern Montana, graduated from Gonzaga University and earned an MFA from the University of Idaho, where he worked with the poet Robert Wrigley and the memoirist Kim Barnes. As the winner of the Boyden Wilderness Writing Residency from PEN Northwest, Wilkins and his family will spend the summer and fall of 2015 living in a remote cabin along the Rogue River in southwest Oregon. He lives with his wife, son, and daughter in western Oregon, where he teaches writing at Linfield College.
