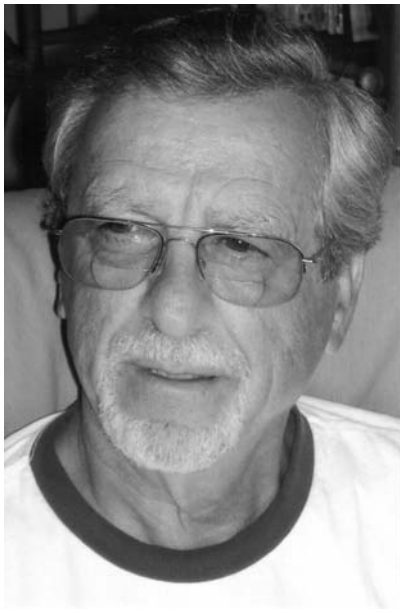

—**Ron Talney** was born in British Columbia but has lived most of his life in Oregon. He is an attorney retired from a private non-profit legal aid program that provides free legal representation to low-income clients. He has published four books of poems, *The Anxious Ground*, *The Quietness that is our Name*, *A Secret Weeping of Stones*, *New and Selected Poems*, and, most recently, *The Broken World*, as part of the William Stafford Chapbook Series and published by Stone City Press. He is also the editor of *Stone City I*, an anthology of Oregon Poets, published by Stone City Press.

—**James Fleming** is a retired Portland police detective and street sergeant. He is the first editor and publisher of *The Rap Sheet*, the union publication for the Portland Police Association & OR Council of Police Associations. He acquired an interest in poetry through a class given by Vi Gale at the YMCA. He is the author of two books of poetry, *You Wouldn't Know Us* from Press-22 and *Heaven Bound*, which was a combined effort with the Newport OR painter Sandy Roumagoux. A recent chapbook from Stone City Press is *The Zen of Wood Chopping*. Fleming is past president of the Oregon State Poetry Association and the Portland Poetry Festival.
